Dear Mr. Peterson:

This letter is in response to an April 3, 2014 filing requesting an exemption from filing the FERC Form No. 80 (Form 80) for the Upper Monroe Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1517).

Your letter states that your project occupies a very narrow corridor which largely underlies existing roadways and that there is little opportunity for public use within the project boundary.

After reviewing the project license and other proceedings for this project, I find that the project boundary does not contain any recreation facilities and available information indicates that there is little potential for recreation use at the project. Thus, in accordance with section 8.11(c) of the Commission's regulations, you are exempt from further filing of the FERC Form No. 80 for the Upper Monroe Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1517) until further order from the Commission.
