**Camp Far West 60 kV Transmission Line Project, FERC Project No. 10821
Notification of Intent to File an Application for a Subsequent License (NOI) and
Request for Designation as Non-Federal Representative for Informal Consultation under ESA
and NHPA**

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section § 5.5 of Title 18 of the Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.), Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E or Licensee), a California Corporation, gives notice to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or the Commission) of PG&E's intent to file an application for a subsequent license for the Camp Far West 60 kV Transmission Line Project (Project), FERC Project Number 10821, on or before June 30, 2019. PG&E is the existing licensee and current owner and operator of the Project. FERC issued an *Order Issuing Transmission Line License* for the Project to PG&E on April 19, 1990 for a term ending June 30, 2021. Information required under § 5.5 and § 16.6(b) and other relevant information concerning the Project is provided below.

Simultaneously, with the filing of this Notice of Intent (NOI), under separate cover PG&E e-filed with the Commission the Project's Pre-Application Document (PAD) in conformance with 18 C.F.R. § 5.6 and a letter requesting FERC's authorization for PG&E to use FERC's traditional licensing process (TLP) to relicense the Project.

2.0 PROJECT NUMBER

The FERC Project Number for the Camp Far West 60 kV Transmission Line Project is 10821.

3.0 LICENSE EXPIRATION DATE

The expiration date of the existing Camp Far West 60 kV Transmission Line Project is June 30, 2021.

4.0 UNEQUIVOCAL STATEMENT OF INTENT TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR A SUBSEQUENT LICENSE

PG&E's intent is to file with the Commission an application for a subsequent license for the Camp Far West 60 kV Transmission Line Project, FERC Project No. 10821, by June 30, 2019 - two years prior to the expiration of the existing FERC license, as required by FERC rules and regulations. PG&E will file the application in conformance with Title 18 of the C.F.R., Chapter 1 (Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, Department of Energy), Subchapter B (Regulations under the Federal Power Act), Part 4 Subpart H, Application for License for Transmission Line Only.

5.0 TYPE OF PRINCIPAL PROJECT WORKS LICENSED

The Project is a Transmission Line – Only Project. The Project is located at an elevation ranging from 130 to 525 feet (ft) originating on private lands in Placer County and extending onto county, private and tribal land in Placer County, and private and Federal Lands managed by the Department of Defense (DOD) on Beale Air Force Base in Yuba County, California.

Project facilities include a 10.9-mi-long three-phase, 60 kV, wood and steel pole transmission line extending from South Sutter Water District's (SSWD) Project Powerhouse (part of FERC Project No. 2997) in Placer County to a switch near the Beale Air Force Base meter station in Yuba County. There are 189 wooden structures and 3 steel structures.

7.0 INSTALLED CAPACITY

The Project provides transmission service for SSWD's Camp Far West Powerhouse (6.8 MW). The Project delivers SSWD's generation to PG&E's interconnected transmission grid.
