Dear Secretary Bose:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E or Licensee), as owner and operator of the Camp Far West Transmission Line Project, FERC No. 10821 (Project), is filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) the attached Final Application for Subsequent License (FLA), pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 16.9. PG&E has prepared this FLA pursuant to the Commission's regulations regarding application content at 18 C.F.R. § 4.71(b)(3).

The FLA includes an Initial Statement, Executive Summary, Exhibit E – Environmental Report, Exhibit G – Project Maps, and Exhibit F – General Design Drawings. The detailed drawings of Exhibit F are considered Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII) and are filed with FERC as CEII.

PG&E is electronically filing with FERC all portions of the FLA following the Commission's eFiling guidelines with one exception: the Exhibit G boundary files in ESRI ArcGIS<sup>TM</sup> shapefile format (shapefiles), which must be filed on CD due to their format. PG&E will file with FERC an original and two copies of Exhibit G shapefiles.

Exhibit E was developed within the context of FERC's Traditional Licensing Process (TLP) that FERC approved on August 18, 2016, when FERC issued public notice of the filing of the Notice of Intent and Pre-Application Document. Exhibit E contains Public information, with the exception of the draft Historic Properties Management Plan (HPMP), which contains confidential information, is currently in development, and is not included with this submittal. A final HPMP will be filed with FERC as Privileged information following consultation with the Indian tribes,

agencies, and State Historic Preservation Officer. FERC approved PG&E's request for a 90-day extension to file the Final HPMP.<sup>2</sup> PG&E will file the final HPMP by September 30, 2019.

By copy of this letter, PG&E will provide one copy of the Public portions of this application in electronic format (which includes Exhibit G) to the Director of the Commission's San Francisco Regional Office. PG&E will provide the Public portions of this application in electronic notification to the Interested Parties listed in the attached Distribution List.

In addition, within 5 business days of filing with FERC the FLA, PG&E will mail a complete hardcopy of the FLA, including eFiling Confirmation of Receipt, to each of the following: 1) FERC's San Francisco Regional Office; 2) FERC's Office of General Counsel - Energy Projects; and 3) FERC's Office of Energy Projects.

PG&E will also make the License Application available to all federal, state and local agencies, Native American tribes, non-governmental organizations and members of the general public that have expressed an interest in the relicensing by:
