Dear Secretary Bose:

Further to Appalachian Power Company's (Appalachian) letter to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) on January 11, 2022 regarding an Operations Manual for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), please accept this letter as an update of recent activities and a request for an extension of time.

As previously conveyed to the Commission, the USACE is requesting an Operations Manual that will include an updated Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), the Operating Plan, the Public Safety Plan, the Security Plan, the Dam Safety Surveillance and Monitoring Plan (DSSMP), and the Emergency Action Plan (EAP), in addition to a table of contents. Since the last update to the Commission, Appalachian has provided a revised MOA to the USACE and according to the USACE, the document is proceeding with the vertical review process, which is expected to culminate in the Commander's signature of approval.

In light of the ongoing review of the documents requested for the Operations Manual and the USACE's request to conduct an onsite visit to review the Operations Manual for final approval, Appalachian respectfully requests an additional extension of time to November 17, 2022.
