Subject: Additional Information Request – Non-capacity Amendment

Dear Stephen A. Dolan:

This letter is in response to the June 21, 2023 filing of a Non-capacity Amendment Application for the London-Marmet Hydroelectric Project No. 1175.¹ You propose minor modification of the project boundary at the London Development to accommodate planned maintenance of project ancillary facilities. Specifically, you propose to relocate and expand the current location of the security fence to improve the physical security of these facilities. Within 30 days from the date of this letter, please address the following comments to allow us to complete our review:

1. Your application does not include a revised Exhibit A and states “...relocation of the fence will not...necessitate modification to exhibits other than Exhibit G.” It is unclear based on the information in the amendment application if revisions are necessary to the Exhibit A approved in the license.² Please review the entire approved Exhibit A and confirm no revisions are necessary. Specifically, the amount

of land and federal land within the project boundary. If revisions are necessary, please file the revised Exhibit A, in its entirety, and in conformance with [18 C.F.R. § 4.51\(b\)](#).³ Please provide the Exhibit A in two forms:

- a. A strikethrough format (i.e., strikethrough items to be removed and underline or bold items to be added to the exhibit), and
- b. A final, clean copy incorporating the changes (i.e., without the strikethrough, underline, and bold notations).

2. The revised Exhibit G-2 drawing in your application is not stamped by a registered land surveyor and only includes a placeholder. This information is on the approved Exhibit G-2 drawing for the project.⁴ Please revise the Exhibit G-2 drawing to include this information. The Exhibit G drawing must conform to [18 C.F.R. § 4.39](#) and [18 C.F.R. § 4.41\(h\)](#).

We note that we do not have the information required by ordering paragraph (B) of the 2015 Order. Please file the electronic file of the Exhibit G-2 drawing approved in the 2015 Order, Form FERC-587, and geographic information system data as soon as possible and no later than 30 days from the date of this letter. You do not need to send this information on compact disc. Instead, please electronically file as explained below. While the Exhibit G-2 drawing in your amendment application would supersede the drawing approved in the 2015 Order, we need this information for archival purposes.
