On May 9, 2024, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) denied your application, which in part, requested issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to Pacific Generation to operate as a utility under CPUC's jurisdiction, along with authorization to issue long-term debt secured by project property.<sup>1</sup> In light of this decision, please provide an update to the Commission regarding your plans to transfer the project licenses.
